tour are a varied lot. Two are outstanding public health officials -Dr. Thomas Fanning Wood (1831-1892) and Dr. Charles Nesbit. A Confederate soldier and surgeon, Dr. Wood is considered the father of the North Carolina State Board of Health. Dr. Nesbit (1870-1938) the city of Wilmington's Superintendent of Public Health and in that capacity championed efforts to implement and improve the city's sewer system and clean water. Dr. John Thomas Hoggard (1879-1965)

Chairman of the New Hanover County School Board for 23 years. The deRosset family has had six physicians in its illustrious history, three of whom are buried in Oakdale on the same lot.



Dr. Armand John deRosset, II, Dr. Armand John deRosset, II (1757-1859) was the first president of Oakdale

Cemetery. Also highlighted will be Dr. David William Bulluck(1853-1914) and Dr. Ernest Southerland Bulluck (1888-1944), the latter who was the founder

of Bulluck Hospital, a forerunner of Cape Fear Memorial Hospital. Dr. William Houston Moore (1880-1948)



was the first chairman of the Wilmington Housing Authority and civic leader whose interest in the beauty of Greenfield Lake led to his suggestion that an annual azalea festival be held.

These men contributed greatly not only to the health of the City of Wilmington, but to the cultural and educational welfare of the port city.

• Pressure wash, paint fences at the Peden Lot (Sec C), Fowler Lot (Sec D) and the Bettencourt Lot (Sec E), which are also orphaned lots.

Tombstone Symbols

One of the most common symbols seen on tombstones, especially Roman crosses is the symbol IHS or IHC. The origin is rather simple;



it is Jesus' name in upper and lowercase Greek lettering, which is IHSOYS/ ihsoys or IHSUS/ ihsus. IHS



is derived from the first three



letters of Jesus' name using the Greek letters: Iota, Eta Sigma. The IHC is from the first three letters of Jesus' name in the Roman alphabet. 🐟
